ORDINANCE NO. 297

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE
DATED DECEMBER 6, 1918, REGARDING
LIVESTOCK RUNNING LOOSE IN THE CITY OF
TAYLORSVILLE.

WHEREAS, Cities are to periodically review and update their Ordinances and repeal those ordinances that are no longer needed, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville enacted an Ordinance on December 6, 1918, restricting livestock from running loose in town, and,

WHEREAS, said Ordinance is no longer needed, in that, it is being replaced by Ordinance # 295, which amended Ordinance #254 dealing with nuisance to include livestock and non-domestic animals.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Taylorsville that Ordinance dated December 6, 1918, as recorded in Ordinance Book 1, Page 20-21 be and is hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after it's passage and publication.
