

**SUMMARY OF
CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 360**

This is a summary of Ordinance No. 360, an Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 337, which was published in full in the Spencer Magnet on June 27, 2012, regarding water rates and water policy to be effective July 1, 2015.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville operates and maintains a Water Distribution System and a Wastewater Treatment Facility (sewer system), and,

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville receives its water for the distribution system from the Louisville Water Company, and,

WHEREAS, the Louisville Water Company is raising its charges to the City of Taylorsville effective the 1st day of July, ~~2012~~ 2015, and in order to offset the increased cost of obtaining water from the Louisville Water Company and to refrain from having to have a significant water rate increase in the future to make up the approximate \$70,000.00 added annual payment to the Louisville Water Company and to minimize the rate increase to the water customers of the City of Taylorsville,

THEREFORE, the City of Taylorsville enacted Ordinance No. ~~330~~ 337, effective ~~January 4, 2012~~, June 27, 2012, is now herein amended as set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Taylorsville as follows:

SECTION 1. NEW MONTHLY WATER RATES

That the rates or charges for water service furnished by the City of Taylorsville, Kentucky, are hereby fixed and established on a monthly basis, beginning July 1, ~~2012~~ 2015 as follows:

A. Minimum Water Bill for Customers Located Inside City Limits.

The minimum water bill for customers located inside the City Limits shall be ~~\$10.48~~

\$10.56 per month, with the base rate for each meter size established as noted below.

B. Water Rates for Customers Located Inside City Limits.

The following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons of water consumption per month to customers located inside the City Limits, for respective size water meter connections hereafter set forth:

5. <u>2" Meter</u> First 100,000 gallons All over 100,000 gallons	\$427.18 <u>\$430.64</u> (Base Rate) \$4.19 <u>\$4.22</u> per thousand gallons
6. <u>4" Meter</u> First 200,000 gallons All over 200,000 gallons	\$846.18 <u>\$853.03</u> (Base Rate) \$4.19 <u>\$4.22</u> per thousand gallons
7. <u>6" Meter</u> First 400,000 gallons All over 400,000 gallons	\$1,684.18 <u>\$1,697.82</u> (Base Rate) \$4.19 <u>\$4.22</u> per thousand gallons

C. Minimum Water Bill for Customers Located Outside City Limits.

The minimum water bill for customers located outside the City Limits shall be \$17.11 \$17.25 per month, with the base rate for each meter size established as noted below.

D. Water Rates for Customers Located Outside City Limits.

The following metered charges shall be made for each 1,000 gallons of water consumption per month to customers located outside the City Limits, for the respective size water meter connections hereinafter set forth:

3. <u>1" Meter</u> First 25,000 gallons All over 25,000 gallons	\$159.61 <u>\$160.90</u> (Base Rate) \$5.24 <u>\$5.28</u> per thousand gallons
4. <u>1-1/2" Meter</u> First 50,000 gallons All over 50,000 gallons	\$290.61 <u>\$292.96</u> (Base Rate) \$5.24 <u>\$5.28</u> per thousand gallons
5. <u>2" Meter</u> First 100,000 gallons All over 100,000 gallons	\$552.61 <u>\$557.09</u> (Base Rate) \$5.24 <u>\$5.28</u> per thousand gallons
6. <u>4" Meter</u> First 200,000 gallons All over 200,000 gallons	\$1,076.61 <u>\$1,085.33</u> (Base Rate) \$5.24 <u>\$5.28</u> per thousand gallons
7. <u>6" Meter</u> First 400,000 gallons All over 400,000 gallons	\$2,124.61 <u>\$2,141.82</u> (Base Rate) \$5.24 <u>\$5.28</u> per thousand gallons

E. Water Rates for Bulk Sales Customers

The rate for water sold in bulk sales for private use shall be based on the "gallons used outside the city limits" water rates for a 5/8" meter, regardless of location.

SECTION 9. RATE ADJUSTMENTS

~~It shall be the policy of the City Commission to review annually cost associated with providing water and sewer services and adjust rates to adequately cover those costs, including but not limited to rate increases by the Louisville Water Co. for water purchased by the City from the Louisville Water Co.~~

Automatic Pass-Through

Effective July 1, 2015, the water rates contained in this Ordinance shall be automatically adjusted annually to cover the estimated additional cost to the City associated with rate increases from the Louisville Water Co., as a pass through to offset the additional cost of Louisville Water Co. to the City.

Additional Adjustments

It shall be the policy of the City Commission to review annually all other cost associated with providing water and sewer services and adjust rates to adequately cover those costs if applicable.

SECTION 10. COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENTS

~~Commencing effective July 1, 2012, the water rates and sewer rates contained in this ordinance may be adjusted annually in accordance with KRS 83A.075 as may be amended from time to time, so as to allow automatic cost of living adjustments based on the purchasing power of the dollar as computed by the State of Kentucky Finance and Administration Cabinet.~~

SECTION 11. SECTION 10. BILLING, COLLECTION AND PENALTY

Rates, fees and/or charges relevant to any/all accounts shall be billed monthly and shall be considered due and payable by the 10th or the 25th of each month whichever applies. If not paid by the corresponding due date, such account shall be considered delinquent and a ten percent (10%) penalty shall be affixed to the balance due for each month delinquent. After an additional ten (10) days of due date water and/or sewer service shall be discontinued immediately. The City of Taylorsville reserves the right to discontinue water service due to delinquency of payment for water and/or sewer services. The re-connection of such services shall not be made until the owner and/or applicant pays all charges, penalties and reconnect fees owed in full. In the event, a water and/or sewer account is delinquent and the customer has multiple accounts, the City of Taylorsville shall retain the right to discontinue services at other account locations.

SECTION 12. SECTION 11. REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCE


Any Ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.
